Block 1

9:35-10:50

*Praise Band

Teacher: Gabe Hollister

This elective is for 6th-12th grade students who are interested in being a part of the weekly chapel praise band. Various positions include singing, operating tech, teaching motions, and playing instruments. Students must be able to play instruments prior to joining.

*Poetry/Creative Writing

This class introduces the reading and writing of creative literature. Students will be introduced to the various types of writing and take part in the creative process.

*Entrepreneurship

This course will cover key principles of starting and managing a business, along with leadership development from a Christ-centered perspective. It will incorporate guest speakers—entrepreneurs who can share their experiences—and have the students work on practical projects related to entrepreneurship and even marketing the school!

*Auto Mechanics
