Block 1 9:35-10:50

*Praise Band

This elective is for 6th-12th grade students who are interested in being a part of the weekly chapel praise band. Various positions include singing, teaching motions, and playing instruments. Students must be able to play instruments prior to joining.

*Entrepreneurship

This course will cover key principles of starting and managing a business, along with leadership development from a Christ-centered perspective. It will incorporate guest speakers—entrepreneurs who can share their experiences—and have the students work on practical projects related to entrepreneurship and even marketing the school!

*Culinary I - Intro

Students will learn practical life skills related to food preparation, nutrition, and hospitality. For students who did not take in semester 1.

*Theatre

We will work on a short one act play as we practice play and character analysis, use of movement and voice as well as improv.

*Photography/Graphic Design

Fundamentals of photography with hands-on experience covering composition, lighting, exposure and core design. Will also cover practical skills of graphic design such as contracting, marketing, website management and basic financial documentation.

*Art Studio

An introduction to the medium of drawing design and painting.

*Auto Mechanics
